#### This funding will be used to

- Ensure clear gains are established from on-entry to end of Prep year Early Start assessments.
- Embed Age Appropriate Pedagogies across the whole school by partially funding an additional teacher aide to increase student engagement and increased student achievement longitudinally.
- Ensure that 85% of all students in Prep to Year 6 will receive a C or above in English.

#### Our initiatives include

- Developing and creating a whole school reading framework and embed it across all learning areas to improve students reading and comprehension skills.
- Building teacher capability to plan differentiation and embed practices to improve learning particularly in reading.
- Developing strong visual learning and student autonomy within lesson to ensure students know learning intention and success criteria for lessons.
- Improve student to staff ratio in the Early Years to allow for a more focussed, individualised teaching opportunity for each student.

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

Provide additional teacher aide hours to focus on individual teaching learning opportunities to lift understanding and hence lift the percentage of students receiving 'C' or better across all learning areas.	\$8,627
Provide release time to Early Years teachers to track student improvement in English and Maths in the Early Years by engaging with the Early Start Program.	\$1,200
Provide focus professional development programs for staff to build capability to address and enhance Literacy concepts, data analysis and coaching feedback.	\$1,113
